### Payment Terms:

- For Reefers imports, SEA freight & associated charges and all origin local charges must be prepaid.
- For Shipper Owned Container imports, all charges (including destination local charges) must be Prepaid.
- For general imports, DLF, CGD, TAD must follow as per SEA freight term, while destination charges like EMF, DDF, THD, RLB LCD, DGD with currency THB can be set as collect.

### \*\*Special Cargo: include but not limit to -

- Meat of bovine animals, fresh or chilled - Carcasses and half-carcasses
- Flours, meals and pellets, of meat or meat offal, offish or of crustaceans, molluscs or other aquatic invertebrates, unfit for human consumption; greaves- Flours, meals and pellets, of fish or of crustaceans, molluscs or other aquatic invertebrates
- Marble, travertine, ecaussine and other calcareous monumental or building stone of an apparent specific gravity of 2,5 or more, and alabaster, whether or not roughly trimmed or merely cut, by sawing or otherwise, into blocks or slabs of a rectangular (including square) shape - Marble and travertine --Crude or roughly trimmed
- Other ores and concentrates - Antimony ores and concentrates
- Other inorganic acids and other inorganic oxygen compounds of non-metals - Other inorganic acids --Hydrogen fluoride (hydrofluoric acid)
- Paints and varnishes (including enamels and lacquers) based on synthetic polymers or chemically modified natural polymers, dispersed or dissolved in a non-aqueous medium; solutions as defined in note 4 to this chapter
- Dextrins and other modified starches (for example, pregelatinised or esterified starches); glues based on starches, or on dextrins or other modified starches - Dextrins and other modified starches
- Polymers of propylene or of other olefins, in primary forms - Polypropylene
- Natural polymers (for example, alginic acid) and modified natural polymers (for example, hardened proteins, chemical derivatives of natural rubber), not elsewhere specified or included, in primary forms - Other
- Raw hides and skins of bovine (including buffalo) or equine animals (fresh, or salted, dried, limed, pickled or otherwise preserved, but not tanned, parchment-dressed or further prepared), whether or not dehaired or split - Whole hides and skins, unsplit, of a weight per skin not exceeding 8 kg when simply dried, 10 kg when dry-salted, or 16 kg when fresh, wet-salted or otherwise preserved
- Tanned or crust hides and skins of bovine (including buffalo) or equine animals, without hair on, whether or not split, but not further prepared - In the wet state (including wet-blue) -- Full grains, unsplit; grain splits
- Tanned or crust hides and skins of bovine (including buffalo) or equine animals, without hair on, whether or not split, but not further prepared - In the wet state (including wet-blue) -- Other
- Tanned or crust hides and skins of other animals, without wool or hair on, whether or not split, but not further prepared - Of goats or kids -- In the wet state (including wet-blue)
- Tanned or crust hides and skins of other animals, without wool or hair on, whether or not split, but not further prepared - Of swine -- In the wet state (including wet-blue)
- Tanned or crust hides and skins of other animals, without wool or hair on, whether or not split, but not further prepared - Other -- In the wet state (including wet-blue)
- Leather further prepared after tanning or crusting, including parchment-dressed leather, of bovine (including buffalo) or equine animals, without hair on, whether or not split, other than leather of heading 4114 - Whole hides and skins -- Full grains, unsplit
- Trunks, suitcases, vanity cases, executive-cases, briefcases, school satchels, spectacle cases, binocular cases, camera cases, musical instrument cases, gun cases, holsters and similar containers; travelling-bags, insulated food or beverage bags, toilet bags, rucksacks, handbags, shopping-bags, wallets, purses, map-cases, cigarette-cases, tobacco-pouches, tool bags, sports bags, bottle-cases, jewellery boxes, powder boxes, cutlery cases and similar containers, of leather or of composition leather, of sheeting of plastics, of textile materials, of vulcanised fibre or of paperboard, or wholly or mainly covered with such materials or with paper - Articles of a kind normally carried in the pocket or in the handbag -- With outer surface of leather or of composition leather
- CHAPTER 44 - WOOD AND ARTICLES OF WOOD; WOOD CHARCOAL
- Chemical wood pulp, soda or sulphate, other than dissolving grades - Semi-bleached or bleached -- Non-coniferous
- Worked monumental or building stone (except slate) and articles thereof, other than goods of heading 6801; mosaic cubes and the like, of natural stone (including slate), whether or not on backing; artificially coloured granules, chippings and powder, of natural stone (including slate) - Other -- Marble, travertine and alabaster
- Ferrous waste and scrap; remelting scrap ingots of iron or steel - Waste and scrap of cast iron
- Ferrous waste and scrap; remelting scrap ingots of iron or steel - Other waste and scrap -- Other
- Flat-rolled products of iron or non-alloy steel, of a width of 600 mm or more, clad, plated or coated - Otherwise plated or coated with zinc -- Other
- Flat-rolled products of iron or non-alloy steel, of a width of less than 600 mm, clad, plated or coated - Painted, varnished or coated with plastics
- Refined copper and copper alloys, unwrought - Refined copper -- Cathodes and sections of cathodes
- Fork-lift trucks; other works trucks fitted with lifting or handling equipment - Self-propelled trucks powered by an electric motor
- Other lifting, handling, loading or unloading machinery (for example, lifts, escalators, conveyors, teleferics) - Other machinery
- Self-propelled bulldozers, angledozers, graders, levellers, scrapers, mechanical shovels, excavators, shovel loaders, tamping machines and roadrollers - Mechanical shovels, excavators and shovel loaders -- Machinery with a 360° revolving superstructure
